Gregorio Yanes Torres was driving his 1999 Ford Mustang with three passengers along Dillon Road just east of Thousand Palms on the night of September 25, 2008. Torres was drinking a Corona beer while driving in excess of 70 miles per hour on the dark, windy, uneven, two lane road when he lost control. The vehicle entered the right dirt shoulder, swerved back left and then flipped twice landing on it's roof in the open desert. While two other passengers survived the dangerous crash, a third passenger lost his life as a result of blunt force trauma to the head. Torres survived the crash, fled the scene on foot before responding police officers arrived, and has not been apprehended.
