



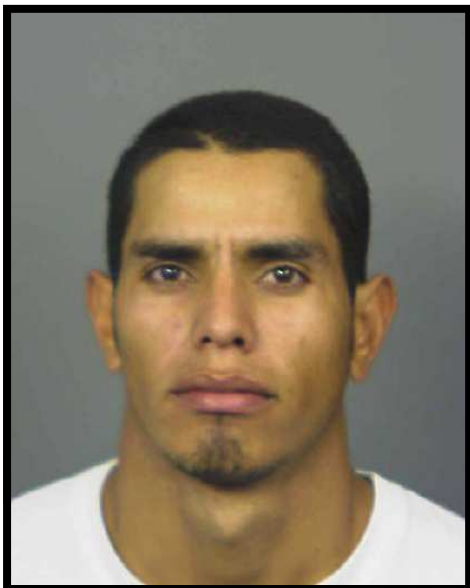

On the evening of January 3, 2010, Palm Springs police officers were dispatched to the 100 block of South Saturmino Road reference a report of a woman screaming. Upon arrival, the officers saw a Hispanic male suspect running from the scene. Officers were unable to find the suspect, who was later identified as Jesus Torres Rodriguez, age 25, of Palm Springs. Investigation revealed that Rodriguez repeatedly struck the victim in the face with the buttstock of a fully loaded shotgun while threatening to kill her. The female victim was transported to Desert Regional Medical Center where she received medical attention for blunt force head trauma and multiple lacerations that required sutures. The shotgun Rodriguez used to assault the victim was left at the scene however it is believed that Rodriguez may have access to additional weapons.
