


#### **OFFICER SAFETY**

### SAFETY FIRST

DO NOT enter any environment containing poisonous gases/fumes Use care when handling hypodermic needles/contaminated objects

Use universal precautions/PPE

Follow your agency policy and procedures



#### INGESTION ACTIVATE EMS MONITOR AIRWAY/BREATHING

#### DETERMINE EXPOSURE SUBSTANCE REMOVE ANYTHING REMAINING IN MOUTH

HOUSEHOLD CLEANER/OTHER CHEMICAL READ LABEL AND FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS FOR ACCIDENTAL POISONING

**INGESTION SYMPTOMS** 

Burns mouth or hands Stains/colors skin or mouth Strong odor on breath Difficulty breathing Sudden unexplained severe illness Vomiting/Abdominal cramping

Headache Eye irritation Allergic reaction

#### CHEMICAL OR INJECTION


#### **ACTIVE EMS**

#### TREAT FOR SHOCK MONITOR AIRWAY/BREATHING

#### NALOXONE - \*\*\* IF TRAINED \*\*

SYMPTOMS Swelling at injection site Redness of the affected area Difficulty breathing DETERMINE SUBSTANCE OF EXPOSURE REMOVE ANYTHING REMAINING IN MOUTH







#### BE AWARE OF A SECONDARY DEVICE

# EXPLOSION

DESIGNED TO INJURE EMERGENCY PERSONNEL DO NOT DRIVE THROUGH A CONTAMINATED AREA REASSURE VICTIMS THAT HELP IS ON THE WAY

**CONTACT DISPATCH WITH -**LOCATION SAFE ROUTE IN WIND DIRECTION WEATHER CONDITIONS PLUME (VAPOR/CLOUD) DIRECTION **COLOR OF SMOKE POSITION/PATTERN OF** VICTIMS **NO. OF VICTIMS** SYMPTOMS/INJURIES WITNESS STATEMENTS OBSERVATIONS

Wait for properly Equipped help uphill upwind up/tream

#### MOVE UNIVOLVED CROWDS TO A SAFE ZONE/DISTANCE

## POLICE LINE DO NOT CROSS

SAFELY I SOLATE AND DENY ENTRY TO UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL



#### Jf contaminated go to <u>DECON</u> Area <u>JMMEDJATELY</u>

\*\* exposed equipment will also need to be decontaminated

#### Be prepared to change location if situation worsens Or wind shifts direction
