## **Drug Awareness** \*Middle School- High School

Addresses the harmful consequences of vaping, illegal narcotics, and prescription drug abuse.

## **Fentanyl** \*High School

Provides a detailed discussion on Fentanyl, the latest deadly trend in the drug world. This presentation addresses the dangers associated with Fentanyl use and the different ways that drug dealers use Fentanyl to poison our communities.

## **Gang Awareness** \*High School

Discusses the realities of gang life and the severe legal penalties associated with gang-related criminal prosecutions.

## **Bullying** \*Elementary- High School & Parents

Provides youth with a clear understanding of what bullying and cyberbullying are, how what they post or do online can affect their future, and what the potential consequences are for bullying-related behavior. ## **Healthy Relationships/ Dating Violence** \*Jr. High- High School

Educates youth about dating violence, the warning signs, legal consequences, and ways to engage in healthy relationships.

## **Hate Crimes** \*Jr. High- High School

Addresses hate crime-related laws and the lasting emotional and social impact of hate language and conduct.

## **Internet Safety/Cyberbullying** \*Middle School- High School

Educates youth about many internet-related topics such as online predators, grooming behavior, and the consequences of engaging in unsafe or illegal internet conduct.

## **Human Trafficking** \*Jr. High- High School

Provides an inside look into the world of human trafficking while educating youth on how to protect themselves from potential tricks and tools commonly used to lure them into this dark world.

## **Juveniles & the Law** \*Middle School- High School

Addresses a wide range of criminal and procedural laws commonly affecting juveniles and the potential consequences for law violations.

## **Career Day/ Power of Education** \*All Grade Levels

Prosecutors, Victim Services Specialists, and Youth Specialists are available to discuss the functions of the District Attorney's Office and SAFE Family Justice Centers while highlighting their individual professional journeys and how education helped them achieve their personal and professional goals.

## **Parent Power\*\***

Teaches parents of rebellious and defiant children how to keep their kids away from destructive behaviors and how to develop strong and positive relationships with their children while implementing effective and healthy discipline strategies that do not involve corporal punishment. Presentation also covers the impact of Adverse Childhood Experiences.
