Figure 1: 1382 Case Dismissals by Branch

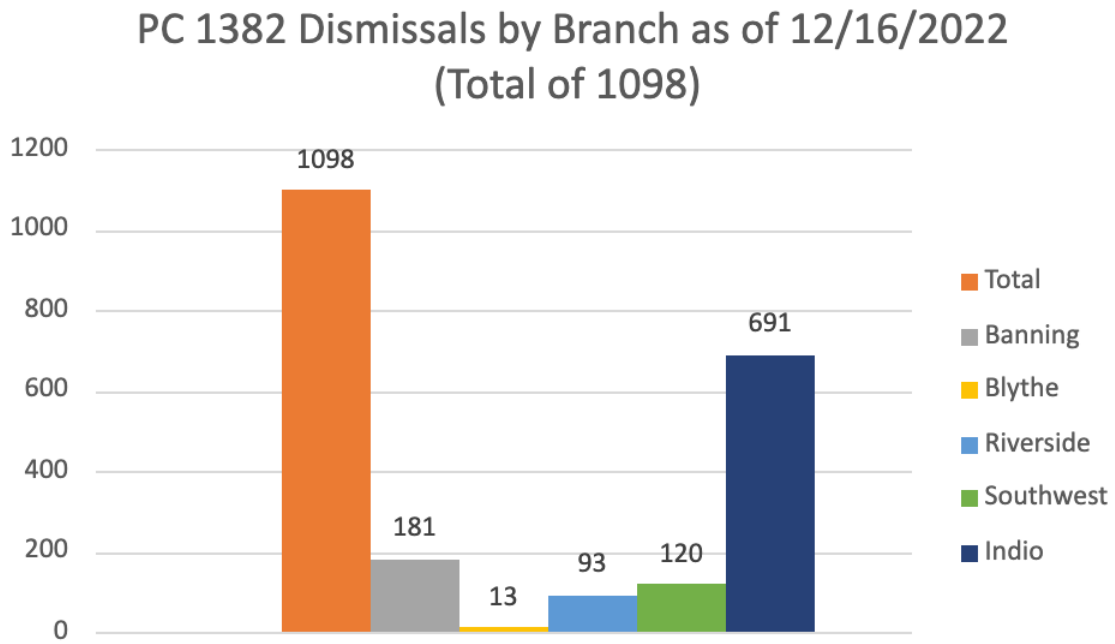


Figure 2: 1382 Case Dismissals by Case Type

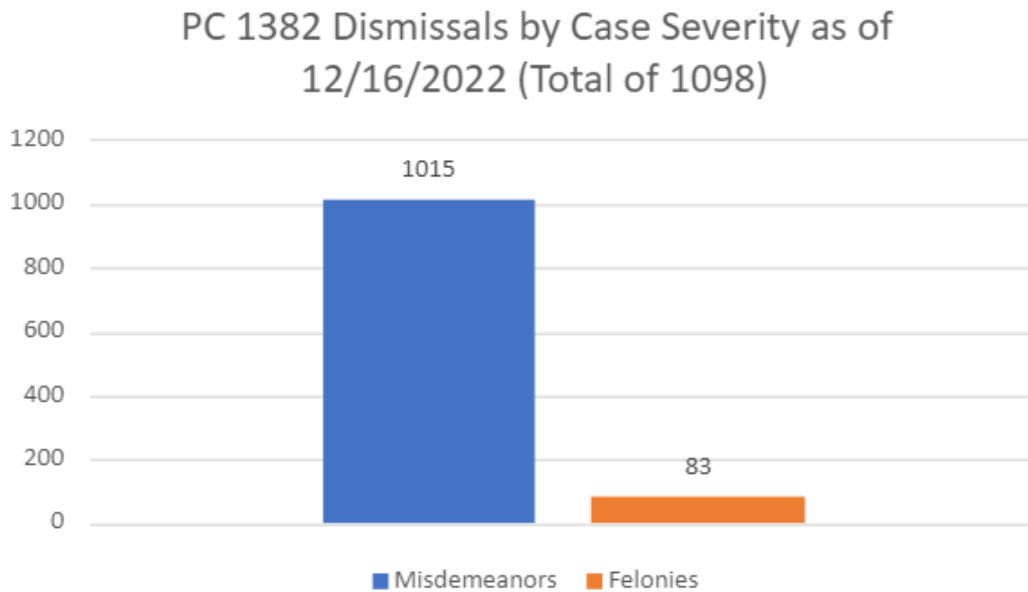
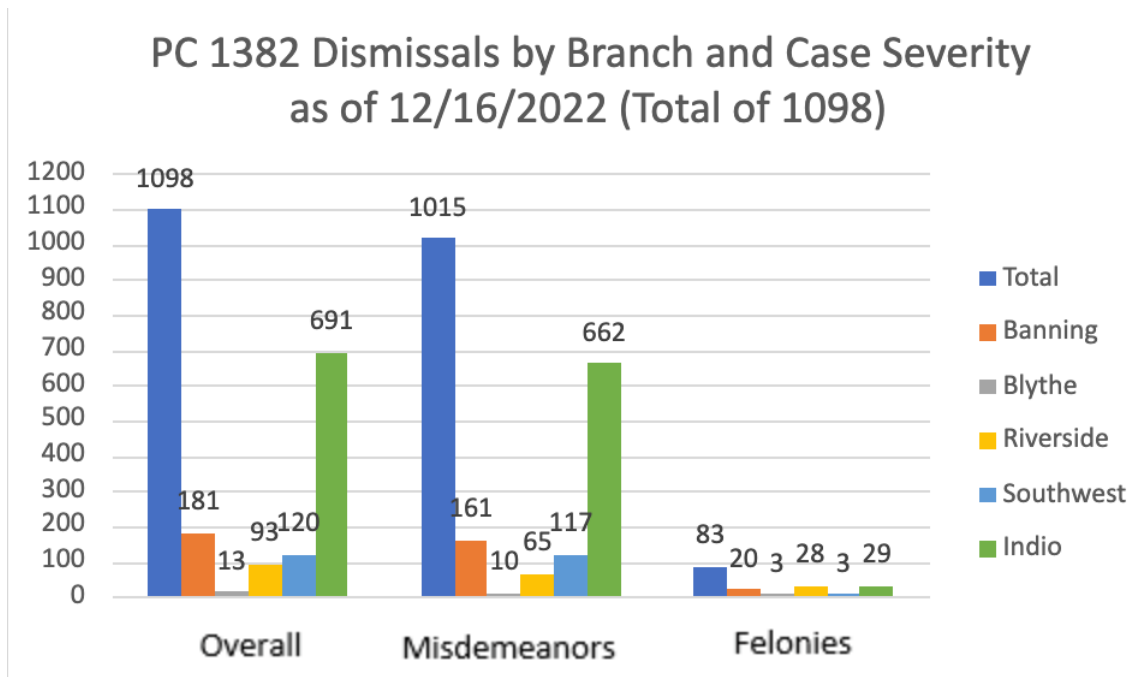


Figure 3: 1382 Case Dismissals by Case Type and Branch

Figure 4: 1382 Assault Case Dismissals as of 12/16/2022

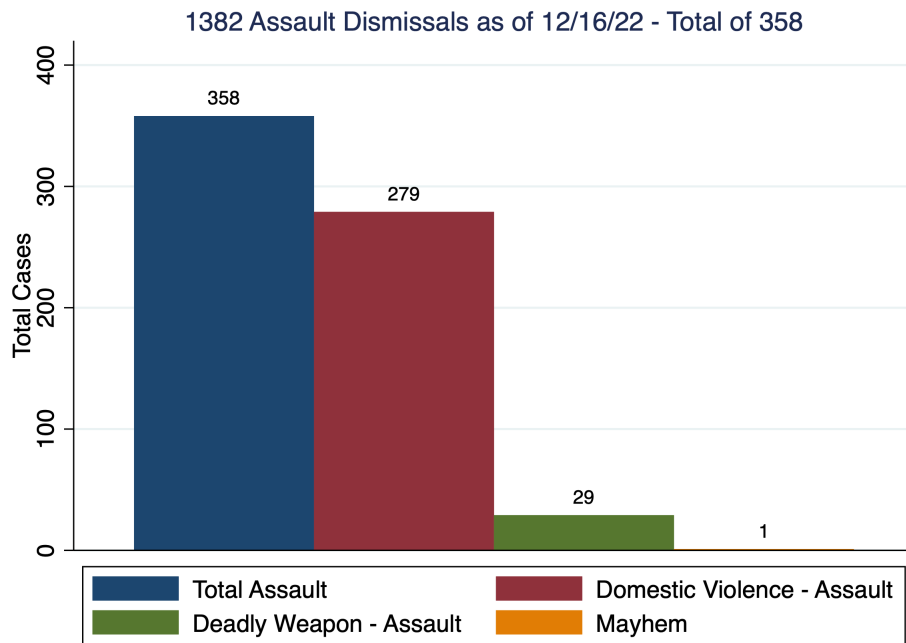


Figure 5: 1382 Subset Egregious Case Dismissals as of 12/16/2022

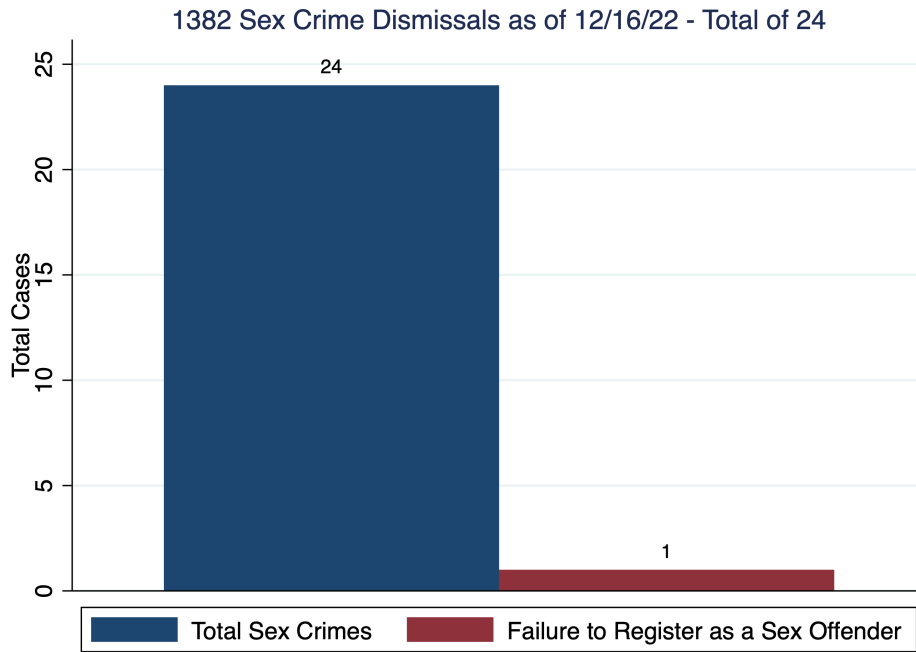
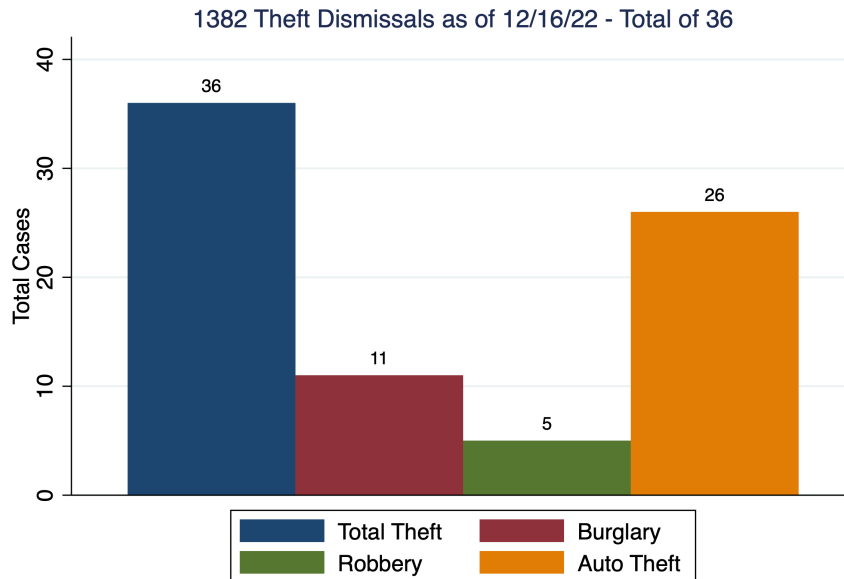


Figure 7: 1382 Theft Case Dismissals as of 12/16/2022

Figure 8: Distribution of 1382 Case Dismissals as of 12/16/2022

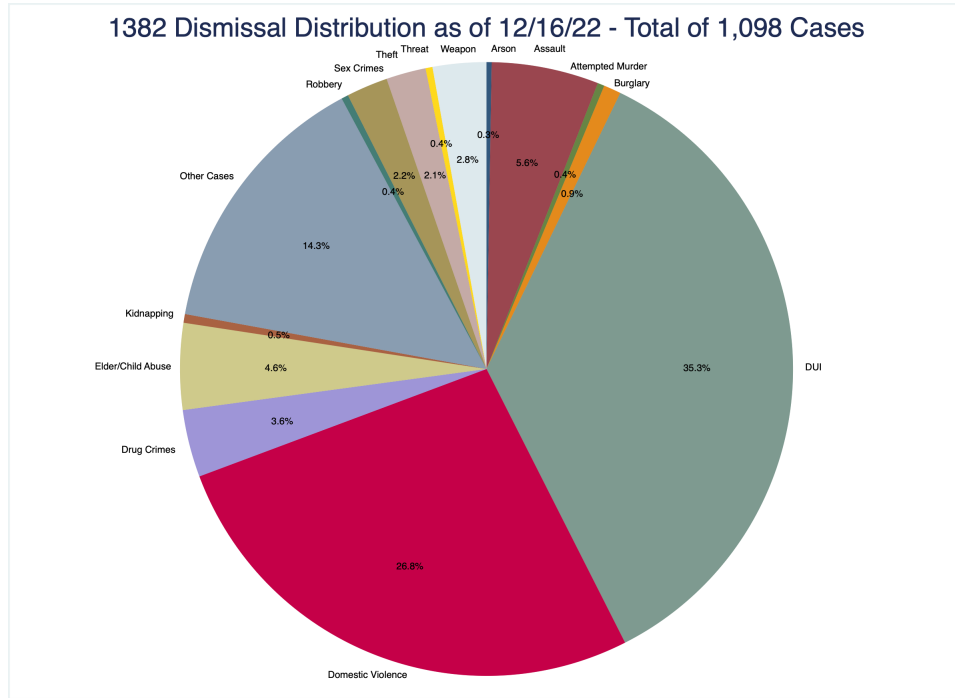
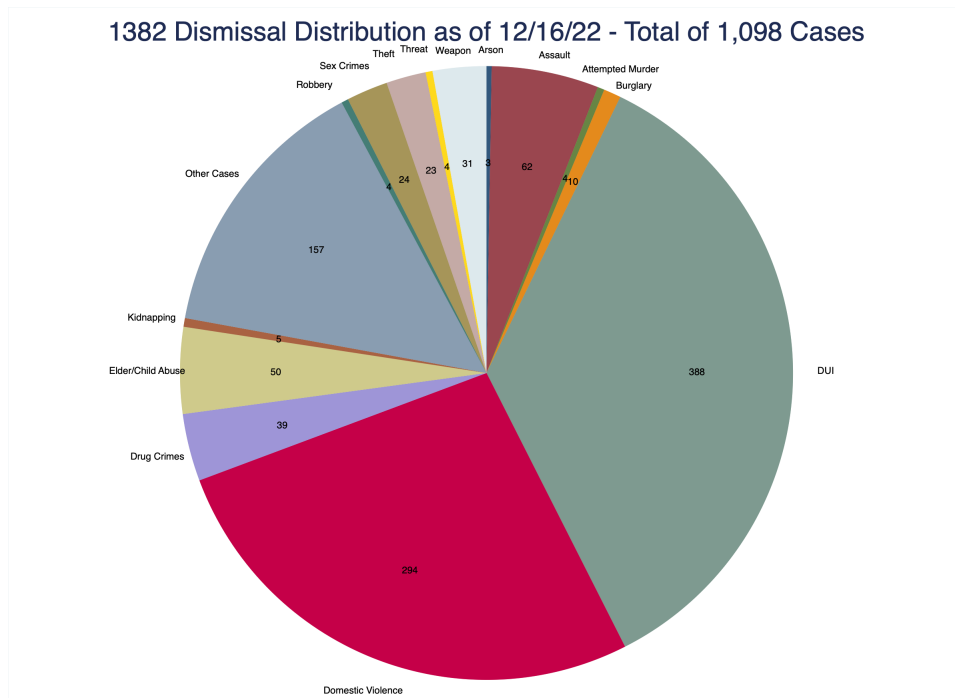


Figure 9: Percentage of 1382 Case Dismissals as of 12/16/2022

Figure 10: Distribution of 1382 Charges Dismissed as of 12/16/2022

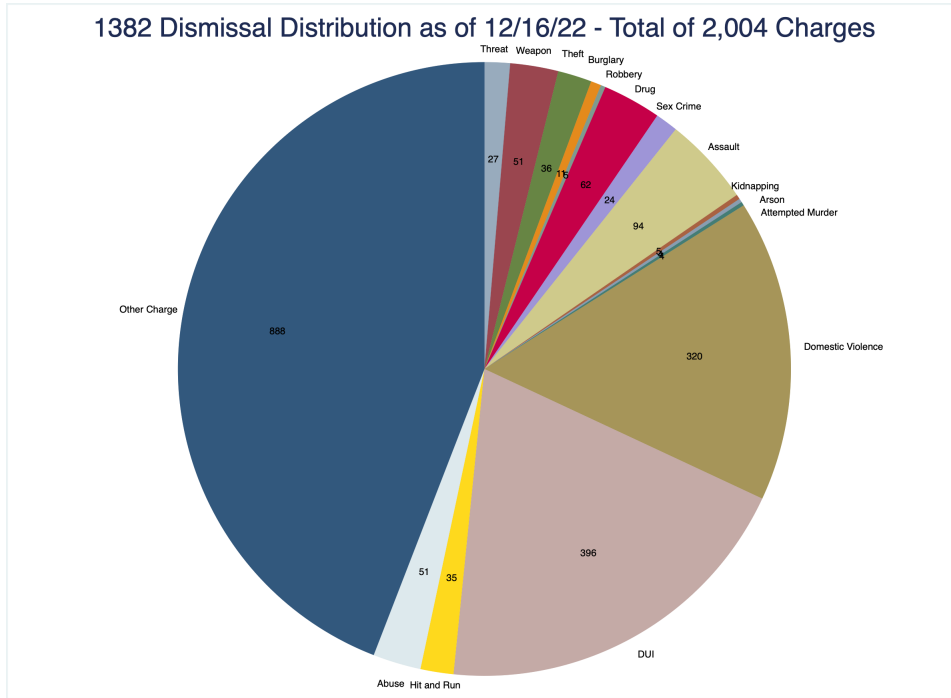


Figure 11: Percentage of 1382 Charges Dismissed as of 12/16/2022
